The Coastal Conservation and Management Laboratory (LCGC) develops research, extension and service provision activities on Protected Areas, Coastal and Marine Territorial Management and Governance as Landscape Ecology. These three major areas of work have been focused on ecosystem services and climate change. The works developed by researchers, technicians and students of the LCGC cover a variety of topics ranging from creation of protected areas, management plans for protected areas, Integrated coastal management plan, Master Plans, Orla Project, Municipal Coastal Management Plan, and to survey environmental and socio-economic perceptions taking into account environmental and socioeconomic indicators.
